Risks of a vaccine reaction

Most vaccine reactions are mild, such as soreness where shots are given. Serious reactions are rare, but they can happen after a vaccine.

People sometimes have other medical problems that make vaccine reactions worse. Tell your doctor if you have any of the following conditions:

- Allergies to medicines, foods, or other substances
- Bleeding disorders
- Heart disease
- Kidney or liver disease
- Seizures
- Weakened immune system

What if there is a serious problem?

If you or your child has a serious reaction to a vaccine, you should report it to the Vaccine Injury Compensation Program (VICP). The VICP is a federal program that helps people who have been injured by certain vaccines. You can get the program's name and address from your doctor or the CDC.

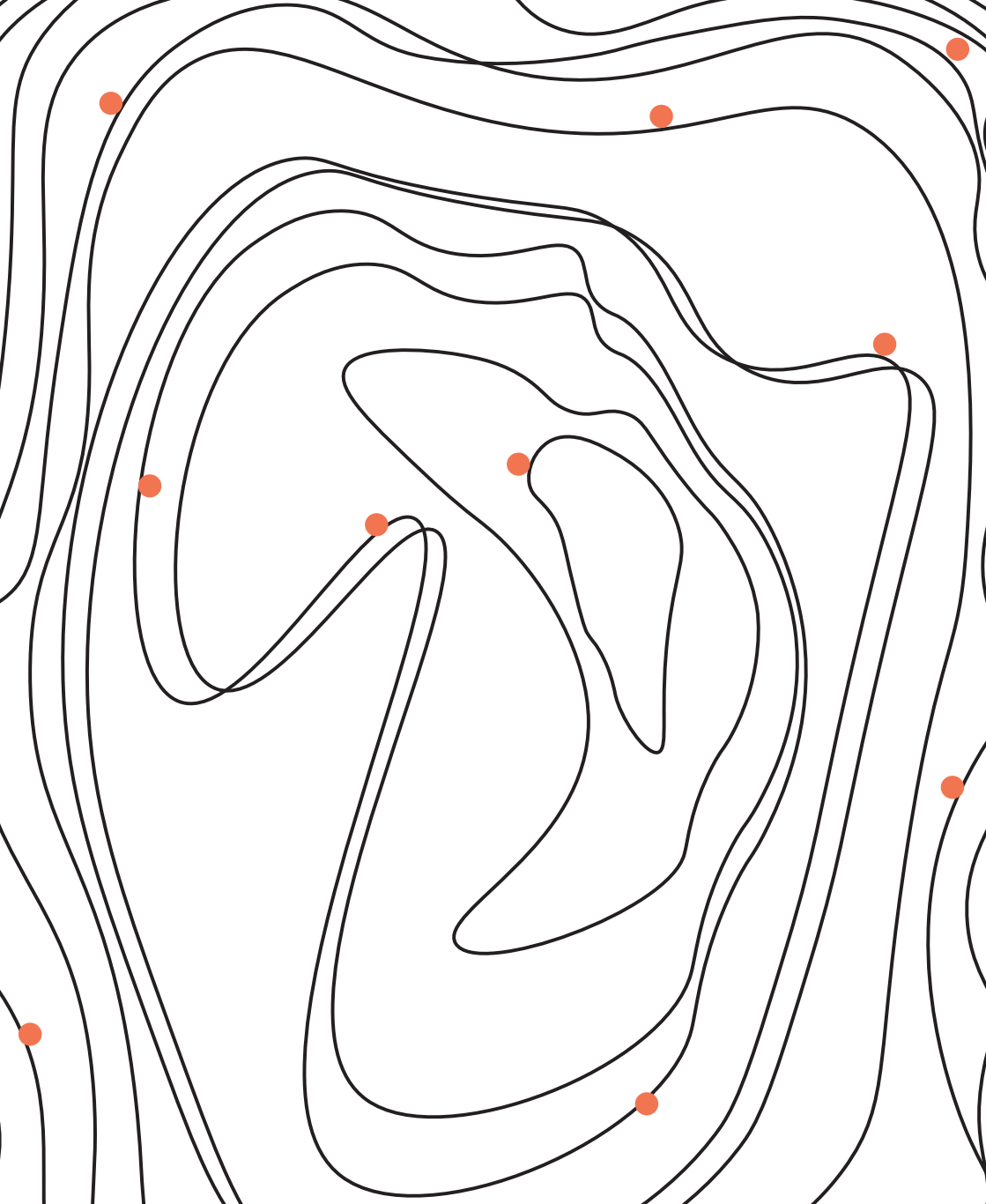
