## WHAT DO WE MEAN BY GENDER BASED VIOLENCE?

Gender-based violence (GBV) includes harms like domestic abuse, sexual abuse and violence, harassment, coercive control, stalking, online abuse, forced marriage and 'honour' based violence.

While anyone can experience GBV, it most often affects women and girls and is rooted in attitudes that allow violence or control to continue. It can happen anywhere: in homes, workplaces, public spaces, or online, and it impacts people of all ages and backgrounds.
