## Why We're Proposing This Change

- ASN numbers rising since 2020/21
- Current model of 15 Enhanced Provisions (EPs) has limitations in its present form
- Many schools already provide informal ASN support without the same formal resource which EPs currently receive – responsive, flexible and managed at a school level

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## Falkirk Council's Proposal

- Every Falkirk primary school to embed **enhanced** ASN support
- All 47 primaries further resourced to support ASN needs
- No pupil would be forced to move or forced into a mainstream class
- Resource would be redistributed and staff supported to enhance their skills



## Benefits for All

- Children would receive local support, now and in the future
- Families could foster stronger connections with their local catchment school and community
- Staff across the board would be supported to develop a greater level of skill and expertise in their practice
- Communities could benefit from stronger local connections between the children and families who live within each area
