


Carronshore

Carronshore has an estimated population of 2,974 and has decreased by 1.9% in the last 10 years. 69.0% of people are of working age and 13.3% of people are aged 65 and over. Carronshore is estimated to have 1,250 households. The vacancy rate (1.0%) of dwellings is lower than the Falkirk rate of 2.3%. 1.0% of households are exempt from paying Council Tax and 34.8% have a single adult Council Tax discount.

There are no areas within the most 20% deprived Scottish Index of Multiple Deprivation in 2020.

Examining the different types of benefits, there are a lower number of Carers per 1,000 population in Carronshore (16.83) compared to the Falkirk rate of 17.67 per 1,000 population. Those claiming Disability Living Allowance is higher (34.12 per 1000) than the Falkirk rate of 9.45 per 1,000.

Unemployment figures are lower in Carronshore with 5.8% unemployed compared to the Falkirk rate of 8.2%. Female unemployment is lower (2.1%) than the Male rate (3.7%).
