24% of people are prescribed drugs for anxiety, depression or psychosis.

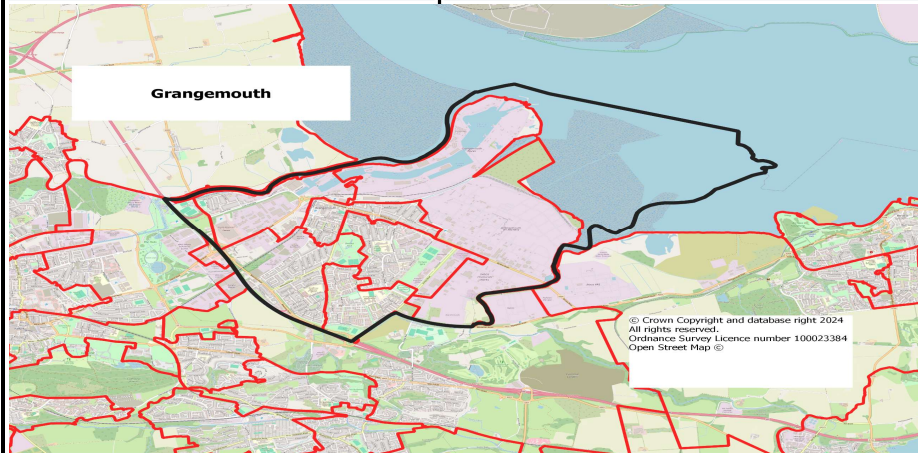
**EDUCATION**
