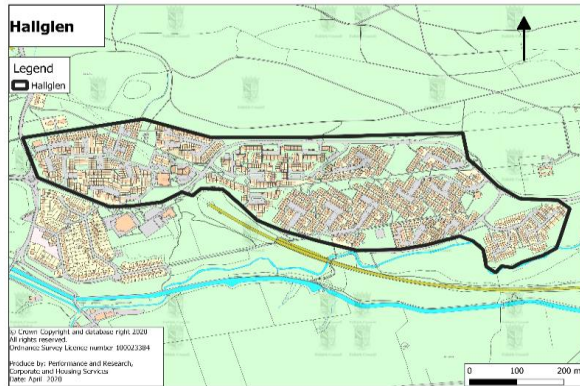


# Hallglen

## Profile

## Map



Hallglen has an estimated population of 3,318 and has increased by 13.8% in the last 10 years. 63.6% of people are of working age and 16.0% of people are aged 65 and over. Hallglen is estimated to have 1593 households. The vacancy rate (1.6%) of dwellings is lower than the Falkirk rate of 2.3%. 1.5% of households are exempt from paying Council Tax and 44.1% have a single adult Council Tax discount.

There are 4 areas within the most 20% deprived Scottish Index of Multiple Deprivation in 2020.

Examining the different types of benefits, there are a higher number of Carers per 1,000 population in Hallglen (21.94) compared to the Falkirk rate of 17.67 per 1,000 population. Those claiming Disability Living Allowance is higher (32.74 per 1000) than the Falkirk rate of 9.45 per 1,000.

Unemployment figures are higher in Hallglen with 11.3% unemployed compared to the Falkirk rate of 8.2%. Female unemployment is lower (4.3%) than the Male rate (7.1%).
